After Ang Lee failed the college (大學) entrance exam for the second time, his parents' dream of seeing him become a professor (教授) broke. Most people would have lost hope for their future success, but not Lee. He decided to attend National Arts School, where he developed an interest in filmmaking. Later, he went on to continue his studies in the United States.

Lee met his wife in the United States and decided to stay there then. For six years, his wife worked to support the family, while he struggled to pursue his dream. Nevertheless, Lee's three Asian-themed (亞洲主題的) movies, *Pushing Hands*, *The Wedding Banquet*, and *Eat Drink Man Woman*, were highly praised and had him noticed by Hollywood. It is then his talent for directing shined in a wide variety of movies, such as *Sense and Sensibility*, *The Ice Storm*, and *Ride with the Devil*.

Ang Lee's first real taste of success came with his Chinese martial arts (武術) classic *Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon*, which became an international hit and won an Oscar for Best Foreign Language Film. His next movie, *Hulk*, though, was a great disappointment and made him think about retiring. However, Lee was encouraged by his father and came up with *Brokeback Mountain*, which won him another Oscar for Best Director (導演).

Ang Lee's success is a good example of how one can still succeed after any kinds of failure or disappointment if he or she has the will and determination.
